



SOCIAL POLICY

The Murrina Group (Murrina) social policy seeks to address specific areas of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander disadvantage, focussing on four key targeted key life enhancers Health, Housing, Education and Employment:

Employment and Training

Murrina will continue to develop employment pathways for young Aboriginal people seeking training and employment in the Construction Industry. Murrina continually seeks to support other programs that are targeting grass roots Aboriginal families to gain meaningful employment and training programs. Murrina seeks to expand its program into rural and remote community programs and projects that relate to Aboriginal education, training and employment particularly in the construction industry.

Aboriginal Homeless / Housing

Murrina has identified Homelessness and Housing as key tenets to Health and Wellbeing and the essential stepping stones to providing positive outcomes in education and employment. Murrina supports “The Aboriginal Corporation for Homeless & Rehabilitation Community Services (ACHRCS)” which has over 40 years of experience in providing support services to Aboriginal individuals and families across NSW. The support from Murrina allows for greater scope and service provision in efforts to eliminate homelessness and housing problems for Aboriginal people.

Health and Wellbeing of Aboriginal young people

Murrina acknowledges the importance of the health and wellbeing for young Aboriginal people. It is vital to learning and is linked to positive lifestyle choices and achievements as they grow into adults. Murrina supports Aboriginal sporting groups and individuals who are seeking to be role models in their local community and, where possible, Murrina will continue to seek out valuable projects to support including “start-ups” that will address Health and Wellbeing of young people. Murrina also believes that being proud of our Aboriginal culture is central to wellbeing and we seek to support cultural education projects irrespective of whether they are one off or ongoing.

Murrina has provided support for sporting groups and individuals and will continue to identify positive opportunities through cultural connections and participation at cultural events, projects and festivals.
